...rotated, growing a healthy soil in the growing areas (the coalman used a horse and cart, so we had a supply of horse poo that went on the compost heaps in the corner). Very few people had a greenhouse and if so, it was very small and only used to propagate or overwinter non-hardy plants. It worked well and everything was organically grown, not for any non-chemical reason per se, just that it wasn't thought about. We picked off caterpillars and removed aphids if we saw them and the abundance of birds, hedgehogs and predatory insects did the rest.

...as a given that the soil was kept healthy (organic matter and weeds were forbidden the shame!). However, every inch of space was used to grow, sometimes with multiple in one row. Lime was used to keep the pH and to help break down the soil in the garden. Most veg grows better in a slightly soil, especially brassica, which tends to 'abbeage club root' in overly acidic soils.

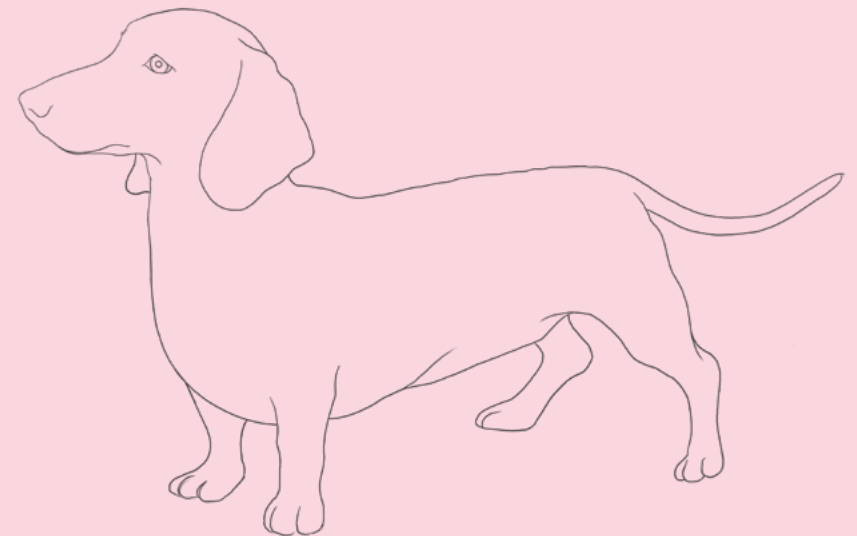

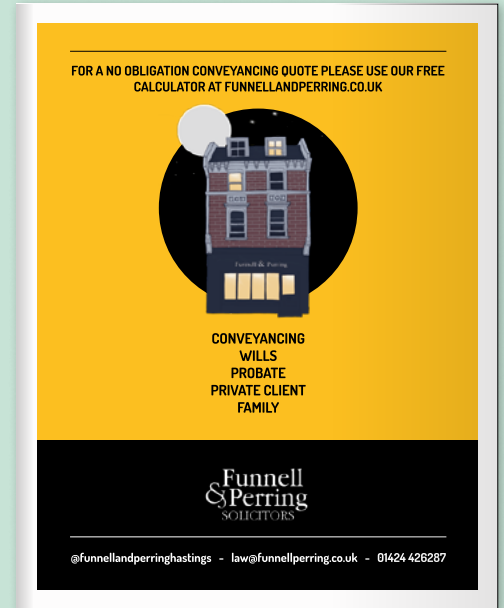
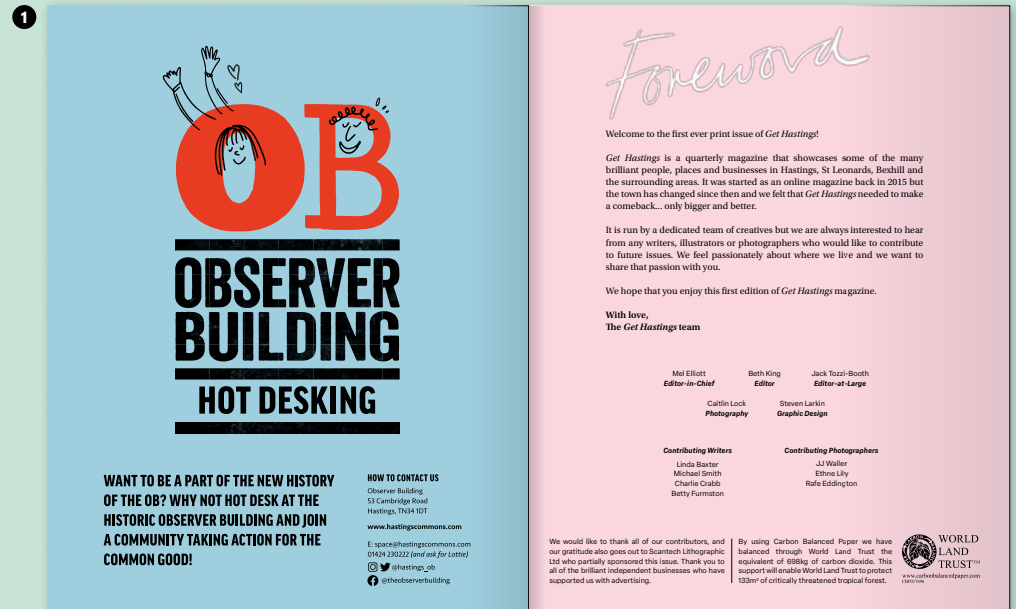
